Lussac Saint Emilion

Grapes

80% Merlot
15% Cabernet Sauvignon
5% Cabernet Franc

Localisation :

It is situated at the edge of the village of Lussac and is mainly located on sunny hillsides.

Owner : Jean Pierre Rivière

Surface : 22 Ha

Soil : gravel on the plain and red sandy clay on the hillsides.

Vinification

Grass-growing, green harvesting. After the grapes have been stalked they are gently pressed and fermented for a period of 3 weeks in temperature controlled stainless steel vats. During the fermentation the wine is mixed with the lees 3 or 4 times a day in order to ensure optimum extraction of the best tannins and good colour from the grapes. The wine is aged in oak barrels.

Tasting

Ideally located, Château HAUT PIQUAT produces a fine and generous good-keeping wine with a deep purple colour, a complex nose of red fruits and vanilla. The aromas are balanced and harmonious. The nose is confirmed by the palate. Excellent length.

Serving suggestions

It goes marvelously well with meat, poultry, game and cheese.



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
